

1981 - A hearing screening test was added to the Pre-school vision screening program.

April 24, 1982 - 50th Annual Charity Ball, "S.S. Golden Charity" was held.

Aug. 8, 1982 - Restoration complete, the Kunze Cabin was dedicated as a permanent exhibit at the Pinecrest Historical village.

Oct. 25, 1983 - League sponsored a new fundraiser, "Holiday on the Lakeshore," at the Manitowoc Elks Club. A one-day shopping bazaar, featuring 12 specialty Shops included a luncheon and informal modeling.

1984-85 - The membership committee decreased the required number of years for "active" service from eight to six. The Elizabeth B. Rahr award was designed to recognize an Associate member who has given outstanding community service during the year. The first recipient was Beverly Vareka.

1985 - Two committees, Project Review and Evaluation and the Historian, were added. Two service activities, Hamilton Home Bowling and St. Mary's Home Swimming, were discontinued.

1988-1989 - The 60th Anniversary was celebrated and an auction was added to the Charity Ball.

1989 - In place of the Charity Ball League sponsored a large Rummage Sale and netted over \$3,600 profit.

1989-1990 - A special Fashion Show was held to benefit the scholarship fund. The show and luncheon was arranged by the Associates. Service projects at the Domestic Violence Center and Health Care Center Swim were discontinued. Meals on Wheels through the Senior Center was added.

1990-91 - League adopted "Project Childsafe", a program to show new mothers the proper use of cars seats and assist with the rental of them from the Two Rivers Hospital. "A Dance for all Ages," a one-time fundraiser, was held at the Manitowoc County Expo. Proceeds were used to reduce the scholarship debt.
